What is Respite Care ?

Respite Care is a short term care that helps a family take a break from the daily routine and stress associated with caring for a child with a serious emotional or behavioral disorder.



Respite can be provided in the consumers home or in a variety of out of home settings.



Greene County offers Respite:

- 2. Overnight with a Provider Agency**
- 3. In the Summer Camp Setting**

Who is eligible for Respite Services?

Respite Care is available to Greene County families who are caring for a child with a serious emotional or behavioral disorder.

Priority is given to the families in crisis situations.



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
